Here's what we will start with. Remember, in this example our chosen word was "whispering." You can choose to let this guide you in the next steps, or you can choose to go in a different direction.




Dark River


02 :: Write the Book Blurb

Above: overlay of brushes texture on left of spread


Phase covers: layering in Photoshop, color saturation, layer opacity and fill, feathering and masking selections, distortion/scaling tools, page layout and resolution issues
